**STEVE GRISEMORE**, guitar, has a long history of jazz education in the State of Iowa. He has given workshops at high schools and has adjudicated state high school jazz festivals. He has taught at several private colleges including Coe, Cornell, Central, and Iowa Wesleyan College. He has also taught at Kirkwood Community College in Cedar Rapids, IA, Blackhawk College in Moline, IL, and at the University of Northern Iowa in Cedar Falls, IA. He was Director of Jazz Studies at The University of Iowa from 1990-93, and is currently a jazz instructor at Augustana College and Lecturer at the University of Iowa.

Grismore has performed with nationally-recognized jazz artists as well as local ensembles over the years including Paul Smoker, Scott Colley, Donny McCaslin, Carla Bley, Steve Swallow, Tatsu Aoki, Charlie Haden, Jack Walrath, Bobby Shew, Matt Wilson, John Carlson, Tim Hagans, Vinny Golia, Robert Dick, Kim Richmond, Victor Mendoza, Ryan Shultz, Damon Short, Paul Scea, Sex Mob, Cory Christansen, John Rapson, Reggie Thomas, Anthony Cox, Mike Lee, Tim O'Dell, Johnny Raab, the Often Ensemble, and the Damon Short Band.
