

**THE IOWA BRASS QUINTET** was first formed as a resident faculty ensemble at The University of Iowa in the early 1960s. The group performs on the UI campus each semester and for schools, universities, and community concert associations throughout the Midwest. Each year the IBQ presents many elementary and junior high concerts in Iowa and Illinois, considering this activity an important part of their outreach. The IBQ has performed at the Music Teachers National Association

(MTNA) conference, the Iowa Bandmasters' Association (IBA) annual conference, the Society of Composers, Inc. (SCI) National Conference, and the MENC/NACWPI national convention.

The IBQ has been committed since its inception to the performance and promotion of new music for brass quintet. In its early years the group recorded for CRI and Trilogy Records, and it has premiered works by Charles Wuorinen, Allan Blank, Paul Turok, and James Dowdy, among others. The IBQ released a CD in early 1998, entitled *Americana: A University of Iowa Celebration*. The CD celebrates The University of Iowa Sesquicentennial by presenting music composed by faculty and students who have been associated with the UI School of Music.
