BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Jim Buennig is a saxophonist and composer based in Iowa City currently serving as Visiting Assistant Professor of Jazz Studies at the University of Iowa. Dr. Buennig holds degrees from the University of Texas at Austin (D.M.A.), the University of Iowa (M.A.), and Western Illinois University (B.M.). He has released five albums as a leader and has presented his music throughout the United States and abroad. During his time as a student at the University of Iowa, Dr. Buennig served as the lead alto saxophonist for the Johnson County Landmark, pianist for the Jazz Repertory Ensemble, and performed with the Latin Jazz Ensemble. Dr. Buennig has been fortunate to share the stage with artists such as Butch Miles, legendary drummer for the Count Basie Orchestra, Joe Lovano, Dick Oatts, Conrad Herwig, and Chris Vadala.
